Compulsory Competitors Briefing

You now have the option to either attend the briefing for the 2018 MBBC Fairway Challenge in person or view it live online.

OPTION ONE- Attend the briefing in person.

Thursday 15th February @ 7:30pm at MBBC

OPTION TWO- Watch the briefing live online.

This option allows you to 'attend' the briefing remotely via Facebook Live.

To watch it online there are a couple of essential steps you need to take both before and during the briefing:

1. You must notify the MBBC Race Committee by email (sports@mbbc.org.au) that it is your intention to watch the briefing live online.
2. Like/follow the Fairway Challenge Facebook page prior to the briefing starting.

3. Have the Fairway Challenge Facebook page OPEN at briefing time so you can participate in the live stream by clicking 'play'.
4. During the briefing, you will be asked to 'like' the live video stream. If you do not have your own Facebook account and you make use of someone else's account or two of you are watching on the same device, you will need to 'comment' with your name rather than 'like'.

Remember, whichever option you choose, one person from each boat entry **MUST** attend the briefing, in person or remotely, to be eligible for prizes, as per the Fairway Challenge Notice of Race.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

The option to watch the briefing remotely rather than attend in person has been introduced to aid boats to fully comply with the rules of the Fairway Challenge 2018 as laid out in the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions.

If you choose to watch the briefing remotely you are expected to complete all the necessary steps laid out above. Failure to perform any one of these steps will constitute as a non-attendance irrespective of compliance with other steps (refer to the NoR/SI's for further information on the meaning of non-attendance).
